# Classic Elite Yarns

### PALACE

On-trend soft pastel colors show the subtle tweed component of this sister yarn to Chalet and Chateau. The same wonderful chainette construction makes Palace interchangeable with Chalet and Chateau and all three will work together beautifully in stripes and colorblocks.

This half circle shawl, begins at the center of the top, with rows becoming longer as you work increases down to the scalloped edge.



### SKILL LEVEL

Intermediate

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

64" wide (across top) x 32" deep  
(at center)

### YARN

**Palace** by **Classic Elite Yarns**

(55% baby alpaca, 25% bamboo,  
20% donegal; 50 g = 98 yards)

MC – 6 hanks 5578 Sienna

CC – 1 hank 5550 Gold

### NEEDLES

Knitting needles in size US 10½  
(6.5 mm), **or size to obtain gauge.**

### GAUGE

11 sts and 19 rows = 4" in Garter st,  
blocked. **Take time to save time,  
check your gauge. Exact gauge  
is not critical for the success of this  
project, but if your gauge differs you  
may require more yarn.**

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## ABBREVIATIONS

**BO:** bind off  
**CC:** contrast color  
**CO:** cast on  
**inc('d):** increase(d)  
**k:** knit  
**k2tog:** knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)  
**LH:** left hand  
**MC:** main color  
**patt:** pattern  
**pc(s):** piece(s)  
**rep:** repeat  
**RH:** right hand  
**RS:** right side  
**sl:** slip  
**st(s):** stitch(es)  
**tbl:** through the back loop  
**yo:** yarn over (1 st inc'd)  
**WS:** wrong side

## SHAWL

With MC, CO 6 sts.

**Inc row:** K1 \*yo, k1; rep from \* – 11 sts.

Knit 3 rows. Rep Inc row – 21 sts.

Knit 7 rows. Rep Inc row – 41 sts.

Knit 13 rows. Rep Inc row – 81 sts.

Knit 1 row.

### Striped Section:

With CC, knit 4 rows.

With MC, knit 2 rows

With CC, knit 4 rows.

With MC, knit 4 rows.

With CC, knit 6 rows.

With MC, knit 4 rows.

With MC, rep Inc row – 161 sts.

Knit 1 row.

With CC, knit 6 rows. With MC, knit 17 rows.

Cont with MC.

### Scalloped section:

**Scallop row:** K4, k2tog, [(k1, yo) 4 times, k1, k2tog 4 times] 11 times, (k1, yo) 4 times, k1, k2tog twice, k3 – 162 sts.

Knit 5 rows.

**Scallop row:** K3, k2tog twice, [(k1, yo) 4 times, k1, k2tog 4 times] 11 times, (k1, yo) 4 times, k1, k2tog twice, k3.

Knit 5 rows.

**Inc Row:** K6, [(k1, yo) 6 times, k7] 11 times, (k1, yo) 6 times, k7 – 234 sts; 72 sts inc'd.

Knit 5 rows.

**Scallop row:** K3, k2tog 3 times, [(k1, yo) 6 times, k1, k2tog 6 times] 11 times, (k1, yo) 6 times, k1, k2tog 3 times, k3.

Knit 5 rows.

**Inc Row:** K3, [k2tog, k3, (k1, yo) 8 times, k4, k2tog] 12 times, k3 – 306 sts; 72 sts inc'd.

\*Knit 5 rows.

**Scallop row:** K3, k2tog 4 times, [(k1, yo) 8 times, k1, k2tog 8 times] 11 times, (k1, yo) 8 times, k1, k2tog 4 times, k3.

Rep from \* once more.

Knit 1 row. BO all sts as follows: K1, \*sl st back to LH needle, k2tog-tbl; rep from \*. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block to measurements, pinning scallops out.
